HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

Alder Jason Schulte called the meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) to order on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, at 5:00 PM at Reedsburg City Hall.

Present: Orris Smith, Lee Gnatzig, Monica Liegel

Absent: Jeannine Mueller

Staff: Brian Duvalle

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Gnatzig to approve the 4/13/21 minutes.

Motion approved

Consider historical information for Agnes Moorehead mural.

Liegel presented a revised draft. Discussion held on additional information such as her move to St. Louis and theater class teaching.

Consider historical signage for Ramsay Park

Discussion held on the type of sign, aluminum vs. vinyl. Discussion held on location, with the preferred site being along S Preston near the current stone marker.

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Smith to approve up to \$800 for an aluminum sign (similar to Creamery sign at Harvest Park).

Motion approved

Consider future historic virtual tour.

Discussion with starting with the Chamber for their 100th anniversary. The depot could be filmed with narration provided by Schulte and Kristine Koenecke.

Consider local video history segments, history room, and historical sites and signs.

Gnatzig stated that he is working on a 1970s video and received a \$1000 grant from Sauk County. He is requesting match from the HPC.
