The mission of Groundswell Conservancy is to protect special places, forever.

We want everyone to live in a world filled with green places where communities thrive. We believe that land is essential for people's physical, emotional, and spiritual wellness. If we don't protect undeveloped land now, it may be lost forever.

Groundswell is a results-oriented organization. Since our inception in 1983 (originally as the Dane County Natural Heritage Foundation and later as Natural Heritage Land Trust), we have protected hundreds of special places in the Dane County region.

Groundswell is one of 40+ land trusts in Wisconsin.

What we do

A land trust is a nonprofit, community-based organization that permanently conserves land primarily through the purchase or acceptance of donations of land or conservation easements.

We help communities and landowners meet their conservation goals. We collaborate with communities and local governments to purchase land that has already been identified in park plans or comprehensive plans. We raise funds from government grant programs, foundations, and private individuals to purchase land and then donate it to a local government as an addition to their park or trail systems.

A Recent Success

In partnership with the Village of Waunakee, we worked with a family to acquire 84 acres of land along Six Mile Creek to add to the Village's park and trail system, and to permanently protect wetlands that help reduce flooding in the Village. We negotiated the purchase from the family and ensured that the title to the land was marketable and that the property was not contaminated by environmental hazards. We had the property surveyed.

We raised funds from the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program, the Dane County Conservation Fund, the North American Wetlands Conservation Act, and private gifts towards the 2019 purchase of the property. The Village contributed 5% of the purchase price. We generally do not charge for our services to protect land.



Pam, Pat, and Dave O'Malley worked patiently with us for several years to protect the land that had been in their family for three generations.
