RFP FOR REEDSBURG CINEMA SITE

WELCOME TO REEDSBURG/BARABOO RIVER RECHARGE CENTER

This will be a welcoming area from those kayaking, or canoeing the Baraboo River through Reedsburg. It will be used as a resting, recovery, and recharging area for boaters and also provide information to those who would love to explore downtown Reedsburg on foot.

Four sided, open air structure. No exterior walls. Preferably wood structure.

Open space, except for center bloc.

Center bloc includes bathrooms, drink fountain with a spigot to fill larger bottles, and a cell phone charging station. Moveable benches and picnic tables would be available.

Information would be posted to direct visitors to restaurants/bars & grills, grocery stores, variety stores, and other interesting sites within walking distance of the center.

We would also make available a structure/mechanism for boaters to securely store their kayak/canoe/floating device while visiting the local businesses.

Ample parking would be provided for those who may conclude they adventure in Reedsburg; or as a launching site and access to the Baraboo River. This could be a starting point, drop off site, pick up site, or end of trip.

The walls of the center bloc could display information relating to the historical relationship between Reedsburg and Baraboo River; and also contain details about the impact on flooding of the Baraboo River.

Artwork to be included could a sculpture referencing the relationship between the river and the city; or recognize the impact of flooding in the area; and/or be incorporated into the storage, security structure that will be constructed. The entrance sign could also be of an artistic nature.

It's envision that this project would gain the support of the Reedsburg Chamber of Commerce; the Downtown Business Association; and local history groups.
