The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for a regular meeting, on May 19, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. at the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Motion by Peterson seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from April 21, 2021 meeting.

Zibell discussed and reviewed the CMAR annual wastewater report with the Committee. Motion by Peterson Seconded by Backeberg to recommend approving the CMAR and Resolution to Council.

Ben from Town and Country discussed different option for the wastewater treatment plant. Three main options were presented. One to do an expansion at the current facility. Second is to build a new plant along with a pretreatment facility for the heavy users and third is to build a new plant to handle all the waste. Ben also discussed within each option there are sub options depending on how we want to treat the solids end of the plant. There was also discussion on PFAS and how this may affect what option we would choose. Chris is currently running some test on our outfall and sludge to determine our PFAS numbers. The Committee discussed these options at length and thought the best option would be to build a new plant and the best location at this time would be land we own east of our new Public Works/Parks Facility. Ben stated he would like to make a presentation to the Common Council in June. Motion by Peterson seconded by Jamison to proceed with option 3 and use approximately 20 acres east of the Public Works/Parks facility.
