Motion by Peterson seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from July 21, 2021 meeting.

Zibell discussed the proposed general, wastewater, stormwater funds for 2022. Zibell discussed a few changes but overall the budgets would stay the same as 2021. Motion by Sporakowski Seconded by Braunschweig to recommend the proposed budgets.

Zibell stated he had a request from a resident to look at a possible stop sign at Huntington Park Drive and Viking Drive. Zibell stated a four way stop here may create backups on Viking Drive and thought this should be looked at in the future when more development happens to the east for a possible round-about. Committee felt the same and decided to keep monitoring this intersection.

No Action

Zibell presented an option to make the intersection of North Walnut and Eighth Street a four-way stop. The Committee felt this was needed since there have been a few accidents at this location and it does get extremely busy during school days. Motion by Sporakowski seconded by Peterson to recommend a four-way stop at the intersection of N Walnut and Eighth Street.

Zibell gave an update on current projects including North Dewey Avenue and Eighth Street reconstruction.
