Approval of Minutes

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Gnatzig to approve the 11/8/21 minutes.

Motion approved

Consider Nishan plaque

Slaats, working with Liegel and Martin, presented draft of proposed Nishan Park signs to be placed in park and by new mural. Discussion held on start of Little League and when to dedicate signs. The season starts in April when all players are there for picture day.

Motion by Slaats, seconded by Manion to approve the draft language.

Motion approved

Consider future historic virtual tour

Schulte is working on editing the video, which will be about 9 minutes long. He and Kristine Koenecke will work on script for it.

Consider local video history segments, history room, and historical sites and signs

Motion by Gnatzig, seconded by Slaats to approve funds to pay the annual website fees as last year.

Motion approved

Gnatzig presented statistics on number of history videos views – 6,100 in US and 8,400 overall. The 1960s video is the most popular. He is now starting on videos from the 1920s thru 1950s. He is also working on live video of former Miss Wisconsin winners and will apply \$5000 Sauk County grant.

Motion by Martin, seconded by Manion to approve \$1700 for new videos.
