Alder Jason Schulte called the meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission to order on Monday, September 12, 2022, at 5:00 PM at Reedsburg City Hall.

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Martin, seconded by Liegel to approve the 8/8/22 minutes.

Motion approved

Consider cleaning/maintenance of historic tombstones

Jodi Beyer from headstones & Blooms gave a presentation. Discussion held on which headstones to begin. Liegel stated she has a list from a proposed tour. Discussion held on QR codes but could be controversial on their placement. Beyer stated that she consults with Arlington National Cemetery for cleaning of older soft stones. Work has to be done when temperature is over 50 degrees. Schulte would like to start with six headstones. Liegel, Martin and Gnatzig will act as subcommittee to determine which stones to start. Smith could fill in as needed.

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Smith to approve up to \$1200 for six headstones.
