### Consider recent grant approvals: HPC website and city-wide historical survey

The survey grant is currently on step 3 of the list sent by Jason Tish from the WHS.

The Humanities grant is a match, so \$2000 will have to be matched in funds or in-kind. HPC will consider next month.

### Consider recommendation for naming of former movie theater site – 115 N Webb

Discussion held on recommending adding 'Mackey' to the name such as Mackey's Market Park. The site is intended for a farmers market, and the HPC believes a downtown location is a logical spot to have a Mackey name. Gnatzig and Manion will submit a letter to Parks Committee with background info and the recommendation.
