Consider name recommendations for all city parks awaiting official names

Discussion held on incorporating 'Mackey' into the possible 'Market Park' along N Webb Ave. Discussion held on a Clare Briggs area along S Webb Ave and the new historical marker in Webb Park.

Consider Cemetery Tour subcommittee membership

Martin, Liegel and Smith will constitute the subcommittee. A summary of the 9/9/23 tour was reviewed.

Consider stipend approval for Cemetery Tour actors

The stipend will depend on the amount of ticket sales. An example could be \$15 for a speaking part. The HPC budget will need to be reviewed first.

Consider liability guideline consideration for Cemetery event

The steps down to the Nisan Chapel basement lack a handrail Duvalle is currently awaiting a bid back from a contractor on their installation.

Consider addition of National Registry buildings for future "Discover Reedsburg" booklets starting in 2024

Liegel believes up to six properties were left off the current book. The list will be reviewed again for 2024.

Discuss local history videos, website, grants, history room and historical signs

Gnatzig provided an update on the HPC virtual museum website.
