Smith reviewed the topics and who is to submit their research on each one. Topics include Grede Foundry, radio auction, little league, Girl Scouts and Miss Wisconsin pageant. Discussion held on off-loading at either Webb MS or the Girl Scout cabin. Discussion held on Facebook advertising.
