Consider Mackey Park art installation

Liegel presented examples of peace posts from Jay Salinas. The posts could be classified as a monument rather than public art since they would be a specific honor of the Mackey family. Martin will work on Mackey wording and Liegel will try to get a price estimate from Salinas.

Consider invoice for HPC museum website

\$2000 was approved by Wis Humanities, so Lee Gnatzig is requesting a \$2200 match for work done on setting up the museum website. Discussion held on remaining budget funds and history tour funds.

Informational meeting for city-wide Historical Survey with Legacy Architecture, Inc and Wis State Historic Preservation Office

Jason Tish from Wis Historical Society and Rowan Davidson from Legacy Architecture presented an overview of the historic survey and its process. The survey covers older buildings within the city limits. Buildings at least 50 years old are National Register eligible, but Legacy will include some other buildings newer than that to stay ahead of the process.

The survey can be used in the future as an economic development tool such as by promoting it to property owners for tax credits. There is an option to hold a tax credit workshop in the future with WHS staff.
