Approval of Minutes

Motion by Martin, seconded by Manion to approve the January 8, 2024 minutes.

Motion approved

Status report on the HPC website transition to City's website

No response as of yet from the new IT consultant.

Consider commitment of funds to the initial stages of Mackey Park installation

Discussion held on installing new peace posts or a REEDSBURG sign. A previous issue with public art was not taking into account the costs of maintaining it. Slaats stated that a broader discussion needs to occur of where and what to install.

Continue to investigate City Hall mural project

The blank section of the Carnegie south wall is still being considered.

Reschedule date for HPC workshop and orientation

The new date will be March 18, 4:00 PM at City Hall.

Report on research from preparation for workshop

Slaats discussed certain sections of the ordinance such as term limits and the council member serving as the chair.
