Consider request for recognition of John Heaton grain mill site.

Ellen Henningsen, great granddaughter of John Heaton, reviewed his history to include former mayor, helped start first electric plant, and feed mill along the river. Discussion was held on creating and installing a historical marker for him near the Baraboo River and E Main St. Discussion was held on focusing his involvement with starting electric power and inviting RUC to help fund the marker. The HPC will discuss further.

Update on Devor bench & Mackey Park

Discussion was held on a plaque, estimated about \$2000-\$3000 and installing decorative caps. Martin will work on wording for the plaque.

Update on status of Phyllis Miller donation
