Consider Mackey/Heaton historical sign

Liegel, Manion and Martin attended the last Parks Committee meeting. Parks will install a Mackey Park sign this summer and will allow a nearby interpretive sign. Discussion held on whether to have two signs for Mackey and Heaton or combine as one. Discussion held on adding Clare Briggs too. Ellen Henningsen, great granddaughter of Heaton, is OK with one sign and will work with Martin on the overall language for the single sign of Mackey/Heaton. Slaats stated he prefers to fund the sign thru the city as it is a city project vs the Sauk County Historical Society. A Good Idea grant could be applied towards it.
