- Vine Street (*S. Locust to Webb Ave*) \$400,000
- S Walnut Street (*Vine to Main St*)
- E Main (*Dewey to Viking*) Design work with DOT and MSA \$50,000
- Waterway west of N. Dewey Avenue \$125,000 Storm
- City owned Parking Lot improvements (*seal coating/repaving*) \$15,000
- Traffic signal improvements (*Webb Ave*) \$30,000
- Municipal building improvements \$25,000
- Misc. Street sealing and crack filling (general fund budget) \$100,000 GF
- Cemetery \$5,000
