### **Consider Mackey/Heaton Sign**

Discussion was held on the sign type and mounting. A laminated sign would last 7-8 years or transfer to aluminum. Bids were discussed from Pannier and Gawronski for assembly and installation, as well as concrete from T&M. Discussion held on mounting location, which could depend on FEMA approval depending on which lot is chosen.

Motion by Hasler, seconded by Aslaksen to approve the Gawronski (\$1350) and T&M (\$250) bids. The location is on the lot between the storage building and skate park pending FEMA approval.
