Approval of Minutes

Motion by Gnatzig, seconded by Smith to approve the 12/8/20 minutes.

Motion approved

Consider historical information for Agnes Moorehead mural.

Craig Braunschweig would like to install a building mural at E main and N Park Streets. He received \$1000 from Arts Committee, but Schulte is unsure if Braunschweig has a request for HPC. Discussion on adding historical text with the mural and will discuss again at next meeting.

Consider historical signage for Ramsey Park

Discussion on location and metal or wood sign, which normally is determined by amount of information on sign (text, photos). HPC will discuss again at next meeting.

Consider setting up virtual display for history room.

Duvalle stated that another municipal museum met ADA standards by offering virtual displays. Virtual would also help former residents and need for staffing. Discussion held on adding to City's website or hosting their own.

Motion by Mueller, seconded by Gnatzig to approve up to \$250/year using own HPC website.

Motion approved

Consider local video history segments, history room, and historical sites and signs.

Gnatzig stated that Covid video is complete. Discussion on next bus tour, which is tentative for 2022.
